#### ACTIVITY 2: DIGGING DEEPER

### KINDY - YEAR 2

Ask your child:

What were the three things that God had promised Abraham? (a land for his home, a family/nation as many as there are stars in the sky and that the whole world would be blessed through his family).

What did God ask Abraham to do in today's story?

Do you think it was hard for Abraham to obey God? Why did he obey? (He trusted that God keeps His promises).

Do you ever find it hard to obey God? Maybe you find it hard to not fight with your siblings, or listen to your parents.

We know that God always keeps His promises. This means that we can obey Him even when we find it hard.

Answer the questions in the box below as you read your bible or watch the video.

What three things had God promised Abraham?

Why do you think that God asked Abraham to sacrifice his son?

Why did Abraham obey God?
